


## Staff Changes in CBC, September 2005

Mr Brian Murphy, as well as being a member of the teaching staff for more than 30 years, was also a past pupil of the College, enrolling in Junior Infants at the age of four.

Brian taught English and History but he will be best remembered for his work in Guidance and Counselling. He was also keenly involved in charitable activities. For over twenty years he organised a Christmas collection and many of the least fortunate citizens of Cork benefited from his efforts.

Mr Matt Foley spent 33 years in CBC, coming to the College from Mount Mellery. Mr Foley taught History but was also Gamesmaster and Senior Coach (recording wins in 1988 and 2003). Mr Foley was Chairman of the Munster Schools Committee and was also an IRFU Munster and Irish Schools selector.
